### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This insecticide must be used on potted plants or small gardens and for spot treatment of initial insect infestations to prevent spreading in large gardens.

Do not use on maidenhair fern, lantana or cyclamen.

Press button holding opening away from you and about 18 inches from foliage to be sprayed. Apply when air is still and foliage is dry; avoid spraying in direct sunlight. Avoid visibly wetting foliage. Spray both top and bottom of foliage lightly, using short one-second bursts. Do not overspray since very little is needed for effectiveness. Direct spray at insects (be sure to contact Japanese beetles). Repeat as necessary.

This spray may be used on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, carrula, ornamental grape vines, Kentia palms, laurels, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, Wandering Jews and zinnias to kill Japanese beetles (hit by spray) as well as aphids, exposes thrips and spider mites. Also effective against lace bugs, pavement ants, clover mites and army worms.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF INHALED:** Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing with soap and water before reuse.

Do not use near fish bowls or aquaria. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid breathing of spray or contact with eyes or skin.
