(CSF) and Labeling  
Drione Insecticide Spray  
EPA Registration Number 4816-367  
Your Submission Dated December 13, 1990

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Change the percent of Inert Ingredients from 90.0 to 94.9 so that the ingredients statement adds up to 100.

2. Add the following to the bedbug directions:

Allow mattresses and other articles to dry thoroughly before use.

3. Based on the toxicity category, the use directions and use sites listed on the product label, this product is primarily for use in commercial sites and by commercial applicators. Thus, we request you add the following statement:

Only For Sale to, Use and Storage By Pest Control Operators

or

Recommended For Use by Commercial Applicators.

(NOTE: This was brought to your attention in our April 7, 1982 letter.)

- Although petroleum distillates has been removed from the active to the inert portion of the ingredients statement, the CSF dated 12/13/90 still identifies petroleum distillates as an active ingredient. Please revise the CSF, identifying this inert ingredient as a solvent in the formulation.

- As requested, the Agency will allow use of the current flammability statement "Flammable" and defer a change in this signal word pending internal EPA resolution and publication of changes in the Federal Register.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### SHAKE WELL BEFORE AND AT INTERVALS DURING USE.

TO OPERATE: Hold can upright and press actuator button.

**FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS:** Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

**FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY:** Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups) and serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation).

To control *Ants, Cockroaches, Silverfish, Crickets, Centipedes, Millipedes, Carpet Beetles, Spider Beetles, Ground Beetles, Earwigs, Waterbugs and Firebrats.* Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using an injection or insertion tube, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases and in conduits, motor housings, junction or switchboxes. Prior to application deenergize electrical equipment. After application allow time for solvent to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the insecticide onto exposed surfaces or introducing it into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

**SERVING AREAS:** Facilities where foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces, such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed)

**NON-FOOD AREAS:** Including garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Repeat treatment as required

To control *Powder Post Beetles,* treat infested wood using an injection or insertion tube. Apply small amounts directly into and at entrance holes
