DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS: Close windows and doors. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions until room is filled with mist, then leave the room. Keep doors closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs. Cover fishbowls when spraying. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
