The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in bakeries and other food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USING.

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

For house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, small flying moths (millers): Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upwards, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

For wasps, yellow jackets and hornets:

Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

For crawling insects, cockroaches, scorpions, centipedes, millipedes, pillbugs, harlequin bugs, spiders: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and stoves, under refrigerator, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects when possible. Repeat as necessary.

For ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

To kill lice and louse eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches.

Spray each square foot for three seconds.

Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses, and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned.

Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

Fleas and Ticks: Spray bedding, floor and floor pets are kept. Repeat only a recommended pet.

Bedbugs: Spray mattress around tufts and seams, and spray into all joint boards, moldings and for treatment as necessary.

Wrap container and dispose. Do not incinerate.
