The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to release of the product for shipment.

1. EPA Registration No. 4816-373

- a. You should delete the descriptive term "new," since reevaluation and your product have existed for more than 1 year.
- b. Also, the "Environmental Hazards" statement and "Statement of Practical Treatment" must be relocated under the general heading of "Precautionary Statements."

2. EPA Registration No. 4816-382

- a. The "Environmental Hazards" statement should be placed under the "Precautionary Statements" general heading.

- b. Add the following statement to the "Needs to be used on Domestic Animals" paragraph:

IN THE HOME, ALL FOOD PROCESSING SURFACES
SHOULD BE COVERED DURING TREATMENT OR
THOROUGHLY WASHED BEFORE USE.

- c. Modify the statement "COVER OR REMOVE FISHBOWLS" to "REMOVE PETS
AND COVER OR REMOVE FISH AQUARIUMS BEFORE SPRAYING."
d. Add "not for use on edible crops" to the Directions for Use.
e. Delete "Does not contain chlorofluorocarbons." This is
considered a safety claim that would misbrand the pesticide
under Section 156.10(a)(5)(vi) and (ix) of Title 40 of the
Code of Federal Regulations.

We note that you did not include directions in the copy submitted
for EPA Registration No. 4816-382. Approved directions must be included
on material for shipment.

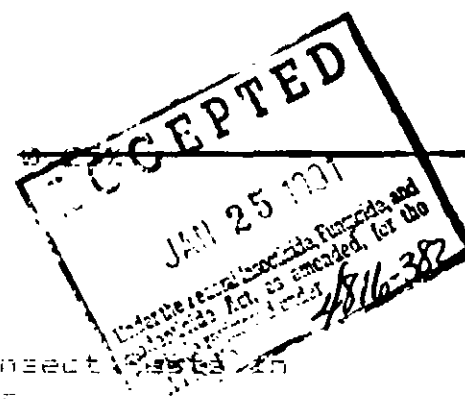
