DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in its labeling.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright, nozzle 10 to 12 inches away, direct spray over the animal until the entire coat is damp. For long-haired dogs and cats, ruffle the coat and spray spraying directly behind hand so that spray reaches controlling tick infestations, locate ticks and spray spraying face and genitals. An application of 30 sufficient for an average size dog; for cats, about Repeat application weekly if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOS

Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATE HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMES CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing with skin; wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination. Do not treat or cause exposure of kittens or puppies.
