1. In the Precautionary Statement, delete the sentence "Do not use or store near heat or open flame."
2. Revise the heading "Physical Hazards" to read "Physical or Chemical Hazards".

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed. Please submit three copies of revised final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

The confidential statement of formula (CSF) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. The CSF for the basic formulation (dated December 16, 1996) has been added to the product file and supersedes all previously-submitted CSF's for the basic formulation.
