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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container and out of reach
of children.

To be used only in enclosed spaces such as
kitchens, food processing plants, restaurants,
hospitals, nurseries, hotels, motels, schools,
industrial buildings, dairies, barns,
greenhouses, and food handling establishments.

Each pressurized automatic sequential aerosol
canister is designed for use in automatically
spraying the space of a room. The active
ingredient is a liquid of 100% active
ingredient. The canister is filled with the active
ingredient, insecticide, and flying insects
in an area of approximately 600 cubic feet. Each
canister is made of metal, temperature, humidity,
and air currents will affect its activity and
activity. The active area protected. Insect con-
trol will build up within 2 hours after unit is
activated.

As described, this 12 ounce can contains
sufficient insecticide to operate 24 hours a
day for 34 days. This will provide for weekly
replacement. Any remaining contents may be used
manually.

To use manually, remove cap and trigger spray at
flies or other insects, pressurized automatic action
repeatedly. To treat entire area, of the unit is
activated and pressurized action button is pushed for
1000 cubic feet of space while moving about to
distribute the spray in the upper portion of the
room. Keep canister for 15 minutes and vent to
late before re-use.

Units should be removed or covered during treat-
ment. All food or feeding surfaces should be
covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned
before using. When using the product in these
areas, apply only when the facility is not in
operation.
