DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mosquitoes, Houseflies, Gnats, Small Flying Moths (Millers): Close all doors and windows. Direct the spray to all parts of the room. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep room closed for at least 15-30 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

Wasps: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Sowbugs, Spiders and Centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places, such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on *Ants* where possible. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Grain Insects: Angoumois Grain Moths, Cadelles, Confused Flour Beetles, Indianmeal Moths, Mediterranean Flour Moths, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Yellow Mealworms, Cheese Mites, Cheese Skippers, Cigarette Beetles, Grain Mites, Granary Weevils, Dark Mealworms and Red Flour Beetles. Remove infested grain, cereal or flour and destroy. Avoid contamination of other food and foodstuffs in the area by removing before spraying. Apply as a coarse, wet spray directly on exposed stages of the listed grain pests and into cracks and crevices where they may be hiding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fullers' earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND smaller. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
