## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply powder liberally to body of animal working in dust by rubbing against the lay of the hair until dust penetrates to skin. Repeat once weekly if necessary. Contact ticks with powder.

Use kennels and living quarters, dust bedding and floor at the rate of one ounce per fifty square feet of surface. Repeat as needed.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

## STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
