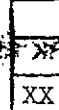

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage And Spill Procedures:** Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by approved waste disposal facility.

SPACE SPRAY

TO CONTROL HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, HORNETS, WASPS, GNATS AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS (MILLERS): Apply using a good space sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Close windows and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Direct spray toward upper portions of the enclosure, filling the atmosphere with mist. Use 2 or 3 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, keep areas closed for at least 10 minutes. Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CONTACT SPRAY

TO CONTROL COCKROACHES, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS AND HOUSE SPIDERS: Spray thoroughly into hiding places particularly in cracks, crevices, moist areas, around openings for plumbing or wiring, under sinks, cabinets, stoves, refrigerators, pallets. Spray insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ant whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FARM USES: As an aid in killing Horn and Stable Flies on horses, cattle and hogs. No more than 2 ounces should be sprayed per head. Use as a space spray in stables and cattle barns. Follow space spray directions given above. Use as a contact spray in hen houses by following contact spray directions given above. Spray nesting boxes and perches. Do not spray chickens. Repeat as often as necessary.

• OUTDOORS: Camping, fishing, hunting. Spray outer clothing and surroundings. Repels Flies, Mosquitoes, Midges, Gnats - if sprayed every hour or so will aid in keeping surroundings free from mosquitoes. If in rare cases skin irritation results, avoid continued contact. Do not pour or squirt - use a good sprayer which will throw a heavy fine mist.
