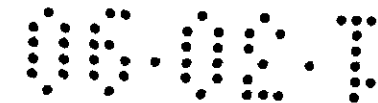
IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label. To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice. Holding can upright, spray the animal with short bursts from a distance of 10 to 12 inches. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the fur, spraying the parted fur directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Draw the fur up to the head. Spraying a cat 20 to 30 seconds or an average dog 30 to 40 seconds is usually sufficient. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control reinfestation.

To control infestation in sleeping quarters, after treating animals, spray bedding, walls and floor with special attention to cracks and crevices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
