STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Do not transport or store below 32 F. Do not reuse empty containers. Wrap and put in trash collection.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Shake well. Apply undiluted Pediculosis Control to dry hair and scalp or any other infested areas and wet entirely. Do not use on eyelashes or eyebrows.
2. Shampoo should remain on the area for ten minutes before washing thoroughly with warm water and soap or regular shampoo.
3. Dead lice and eggs should be removed with special nit comb provided.
4. Repeat treatment in 7-10 days to kill any newly hatched lice. Do not exceed two consecutive applications within 24 hours.

To eliminate infestation, it is important to wash all clothing and bedding of infested person at time of treatment.
