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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Water dilutions should be prepared at room temperature. Exposure to low temperatures may cause cloudiness or crystalization.

SURFACE SPRAY

This concentrate should be diluted with water before use, at a rate of 1 part concentrate to 9 parts water. The diluted spray should be applied in conventional, mechanical or compressed air spraying or logging equipment. It is not recommended for use in thermal generating equipment.

To control Cockrosches, Ants, Spiders, Silverlish, Crickets, Cent'pedes, Earwigs, Sowbugs and Grain Mites: Apply as a coarse droplet spray, directed into cracks, crevices and other hiding places, along baseboards, around the bases of machinery and under pattets. Treat all returned bottle cartons and cases. Spray thoroughly, contacting insects directly whenever possible. Spray badly infested areas whenever possible. Spray badly infested areas daily. In other areas, repeat treatment twice weekly or when reinfestation occurs.
