DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPACE SPRAY

For rapid control of house flies, fruit flies, mosquitoes, flying roaches and gnats. Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Apply using a good sprayer, adjusted to deliver a fine mist. Direct spray toward upper portions of the enclosure filling the room with mist. Use 1/2 to 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space.

To kill exposed stages of cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, crickets, etc., confused flour beetle, star lined grain beetles, red flour beetle, etc. with all granary weevil and grain mites. Treat as above using 2 to 5 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 15 minutes. Vacate treated area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment when reinfestation occurs.

SURFACE SPRAY

To insure maximum control of the crawling insects named above, apply as a surface mist directed toward insect infested areas of crevices, along baseboards, around the base of machinery, containers, etc. stored prior to, and other areas where insects may hide. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry. Spray badly infested areas daily. In other areas, repeat treatment twice weekly or when reinfestation occurs.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs. Do not apply as a space spray while food processing is underway. Except in federally inspected meat and poultry plants, when applied as a surface spray with care and in accordance with the directions and precautions given above, food processing operations may continue. Food should be removed or covered before treatments. All surfaces in processing areas must be washed and rinsed with potable water after spraying. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

If Inhaled. Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on Skin. Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area of skin with soap and water.
