Subject: Revised Labeling and Confidential Statements of Formula
Tetralate Multi-Purpose Insect Killer
EPA Registration Number 4816-493
Submissions Dated November 29, 1995

The confidential statements of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated October 25, 1995) supersedes all previously-approved confidential statements of formula for the basic formulation.
2. The confidential statement of formula for an alternate formulation (dated October 25, 1995) has been added to the file for this product.
3. Box 10 of each of these confidential statements of formula contains an error. The active ingredient Resmethrin is listed as 0.44% active in the source product. The calculations of nominal concentrations and certified limits, however, are based on the accurate percentage of 10.6%. For the record, submit revised confidential statements of formula that reflect the active ingredient concentration in the source product as being 10.6%.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the first paragraph of the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

2. Move the second paragraph of the Precautionary Statements to the Directions for Use.
3. Delete the sentence "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters." from the Environmental Hazards statement. This sentence is not appropriate since this product is an aerosol.
4. Delete the sentence "Do not spraying bearing fruit trees." from the Precautionary Statements. This statement is already included in the Directions for Use.

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before reuse. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

Cover or remove fishbowls for one hour. Do not use on or around animals.

Environmental Hazards

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage and Disposal

Store in a cool, dry area. Do not store or transport below 32°F.

Container Disposal: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

SHAKE BEFORE USE: Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet from surfaces which may stain and 18 inches from plants.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS AROUND THE HOME
FLYING INSECTS (*Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Moths*): Direct spray at insects using short bursts (1-2 seconds) or treat unoccupied areas as follows: Close doors and windows. With a sweeping motion, direct spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not remain in treated areas.

CRAWLING PESTS (*Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Crickets, Earwigs and Sowbugs*): Spray into cracks or wood-work, walls, floors and other hiding and breeding places. Direct spray to contact pests when possible. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames.

WASPS and HORNETS: Direct spray at these insects using short bursts. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: For control of *Aphids, Two-spotted spider mites* and *Adult Whiteflies* on ornamental house and greenhouse plants (African violets, aralias, Christmas cherries, chrysanthemums, cinerarias, diffenbachias, fuschias, gloxinias, ivy, lantanas, neanthe bella Palms, petunias, roses and snapdragons); and outdoor plants (azaleas, chrysanthemums, euonymus, ivy, marigolds, petunias, roses, snapdragons and zinnias). Spray plants with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as necessary. When using outdoors, spray when air is still.

For control of these pests as well as *Tent Caterpillars, Canker Worms*, and *Garden Webworms* on ornamental crabapples, cherries and plum trees, spray as above. Do not spray bearing fruit trees.
