BATCH

It is a violation of Federal law to use
this product in a manner inconsistent with
its labeling.

SPACE SPRAY

For rapid control of house flies, fruit
flies, mosquitoes, flying moths and gnats.
Close doors and windows and shut off
ventilating systems. Apply using a good
sprayer adjusted to deliver a fine mist.
Direct spray toward upper portions of the
enclosure filling the room with mist. Use
1/2 to 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space.

To kill exposed stages of cockroaches,
ants, spiders, clover mites, cheese mites,
confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain
beetles, red flour beetles, rice weevils,
granary weevils and grain mites. Treat as
above using 2 to 3 ounces per 1000 cubic
feet of space. Keep area closed for at
least 15 minutes. Vacate treated area and
ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat
treatment when reinfestation occurs.

SURFACE SPRAY

To insure maximum control of the crawling
insects named above, apply as a coarse mist
directed toward insects, into cracks and
crevices, along baseboards, around the
base of machinery, containers of stored
products and other areas where insects may
hide. Spray ant trails, nests and points
of entry. Spray badly infested areas daily.
In other areas, repeat treatment twice
weekly or when reinfestation occurs.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap con-
tainer and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination
of feed and foodstuffs. Do not apply as a
space spray while food processing is under-
way. Except in Federally inspected meat
and poultry plants, when applied as a
surface spray with care and in accordance
with the directions and precautions given
above, food processing operations may
continue. Foods should be removed or
covered before treatments. All surfaces in
processing areas must be washed and rinsed
with potable water after spraying. Remove
pets and birds and cover fish aquariums
before spraying.
