The confidential statements of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated October 25, 1995) supersedes all previously-approved confidential statements of formula for the basic formulation. The confidential statement of formula for an alternate formulation (dated October 25, 1995) has been added to the file for this product.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:

"CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

Butamin Indoor/Outdoor Spray is intended for use indoors and in backyards, patios and picnic areas.

SHAKE BEFORE USING

TO KILL ANTS, CENTIPEDES, and CRICKETS: Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray ant hills and trails for best control. Repeat as necessary.

When properly directed, the spray mist will kill *Flies*, *Mosquitoes*, and *Gnats* up to 20 feet away. Point valve opening away from face. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray from center of area to be treated when not breezy. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS and SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and spray all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep the room closed for 15 minutes after treatment. Ventilate the room completely before re-entry. Repeat treatment as necessary.
