Remove and destroy pet's old hedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around base-boards, window and door frames, sall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. But fresh bedding in pers quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
