Subject: Amendment - Label Update for Pyrenone Diazinon E.C.
EPA Registration No. 4816-517
Your Application Dated January 27, 1988

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Delete "Kills Resistant Cockroaches" or else specify the nature of resistance and support the claim with appropriate data.
2. Xylene Range Aromatic Solvent and petroleum distillate are both solvents and are not considered to be active ingredients in this type formulation. Therefore, delete them from the active ingredient statement and include them in the total percentage of "Inert Ingredients." Since these chemicals may present an "aspiration hazard" if the product were accidentally ingested, add the following phrase beneath the ingredient statement:

*Contains petroleum distillates and xylene range aromatic solvents.

(The asterisk should also be placed above "Inert Ingredients.")

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- 3. Revise the Note to Physician as follows:

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered but only in conjunction with atropine.

- 4. Change the second sentence under Environmental Hazards as follows:

Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of equipment washwaters.

- 5. Add the following sentence under Physical or Chemical Hazards:

Do not use this product in conduits, motor housings and junction or switch boxes because of shock hazard.

- 6. Based upon the use pattern and methods of application the statement "This product must not be used on gold courses . . ." may be deleted from the labeling.

Use in food handling establishments can infer use in the United States Department of Agricultural (USDA) Meat and Poultry Plants. Therefore, either add the statement "Not for Use in USDA Meat and Poultry Plants" or submit an application to USDA requesting use in these areas. If granted, you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in these areas.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
