DIRECTIONS FOR USE

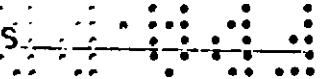
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ON HORSES AND PONIES: Brush the animal thoroughly to remove loose dirt and dust. Prepare the appropriate dilution of Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide in the amount required for immediate use (about one quart per horse). Diluted Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide should be used within 24 hours.

To kill and repel HORSE FLIES, HORN FLIES, GNATS and MOSQUITOES: Dilute 1 part Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide with 9 parts water. First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Wash (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the animal. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, flanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin. After medication, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on coat. Repeat daily or as required.

To Kill and Repel HORSE FLIES, STABLE FLIES, HORN FLIES and FACE FLIES: Dilute 1 part Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide with 9 parts water. Moisten (do not soak) a folded 12" square piece of tulle or gauze with the dilution. Rub against, then with hair growth. Give special attention to facial areas, neck, legs, shoulders, and flanks where flies are most often seen. Avoid contact with eyes or nostrils. Apply thoroughly to moisten hair. If desired, the sheen of the coat may be enhanced by light brushing following application. For best results, apply Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide daily.

To Kill Attached TICKS: Saturate a cloth with this concentrate and dab directly on ticks. Avoid contact with eyes or nostrils.

IN HORSE BARN, STABLE AND TACK ROOMS: To control flies, mosquitoes and gnats, dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate to 4 parts water or oil and apply as a fog or fine mist directing spray toward the ceiling and upper corners until the area is filled with mist using about 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed for ten to fifteen minutes. Vacate the area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PRECAUTIONS: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Insecticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.
CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Not for use on horses intended for food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
IF ON CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
