The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Change the label signal word from "CAUTION" to "WARNING."
2. Under the Precautionary Statements, add the following:  
  
Causes substantial but temporary eye injury.  
Wear goggles, face shield, or safety glasses.
3. Modify the first sentence under IF INHALED as follows:  
  
Remove victim to fresh air and call a physician  
if effects occur.
4. Update and expand the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish.  
Do not apply directly to water. Do not
