EPA Registration No. 4816-552
Your Application Dated January 30, 1989

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The signal word "Warning" should also be located in the Hazards to Humans section, just before "Harmful if swallowed." If the entire label is all front panel, it is not necessary to repeat the signal word under this heading.
2. Under the use directions, add "An insecticide for formulating use only. Formulators using this product are responsible for getting EPA Registration for their products."
3. Update the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

Environmental Hazards Statement

"This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.
