The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling change bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. We have reviewed your primary eye irritation study (MRID 437997-04) that was submitted as 6(a)(2) study and find it acceptable. It has been assigned a toxicity category I with a signal word DANGER. As a result of this toxicity category we have the following labeling comments:
 - a. The following must be included under Precautionary Statements: "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."
 - b. The Statement of Practical Treatment must include:

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gently stream of water for 15 minutes. Get

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

c. Under Storage and Disposal add the following:

"Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."

The category I classification for primary eye irritation triggers restricted use for the non-manufacturing use products, Registration No's. 432-786 and 4816-689. We will not require you to label these two products "Restricted Use Pesticide" if you certify that your product's packaging is child resistant. In our October 16, 1995 (for Reg. No. 4816-552) letter we requested that identify how much of each product is in the market with the WARNING signal word. Also, do you plan to resticker existing stock with the aforementioned labeling changes? This matter should be addressed immediately.

Submit three copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
