The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- 1. The word "Caution" should immediately precede "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals." If the entire label is all front panel, it is not necessary to repeat the signal word under this heading.
- 2. Update the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

# Environmental Hazards Statement

- 5. Revise the pesticide disposal statement as follows:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
