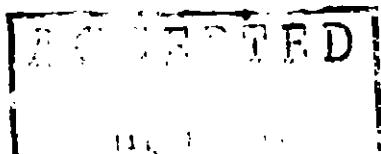

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in violation of labeling.

To be used only in non-residential food handling areas to control an annoyance: in Food Processing Plants, Restaurants, Schools and other Public Buildings; in Dairies, and other Food Handling Establishments.

This product is designed for use in automatically-operated spray nozzles. The metered valve provided, which gives a dosage of fifteen minutes, one unit will control *Flies, Mosquitoes* in an area of approximately 6000 cubic feet. Temperature, humidity and air currents all affect insect control area protected. Insect control will build up within 24 hours.

Used as described, this 6.5 ounce can contains sufficient spray for 28 hours a day for 28 days. This will provide for replacement of remaining contents may be used manually.

To use manually, remove cap and direct spray at insect source. Push actuator button repeatedly. To treat entire area, clean insect source, push actuator button 7 times per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct the spray in the upper portion of the room. Keep area ventilated before reoccupying.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Surfaces should be covered during treatment. After effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water wash. When using the product in these areas, apply only where necessary.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place and away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in plastic and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
