After washing and cleaning up the inside of the processing plant and just prior to loading, fruit lot #1, the entire space inside the plant, should be sprayed at a dilution of 6 parts concentrate to 59 parts water (6 pints) with 7 gallons, 3 pints water or 12 table-spoonful with 32 pints water). At the rate of 1 gallon to 750 square feet (1 quart to 750 square feet) direct spray on walls, ceilings, and floors, paying special attention to forcing spray into all cracks and crevices.
