## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This insecticide may be used outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the entire growing season or as a preharvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

Outdoors or in greenhouses: to control the insects named below, dilute from 0.6 to 1.5 fluid ounces of concentrate with water to make 5 gallons of spray (or 1 to 3 tablespoons per 1 gallon). Apply to insure thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces.

Prepare only the amount of spray required. Holding dilute spray more than 24 hours is not recommended.
