Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

Caution

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin; wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Physical Or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright, nozzle away from you. With nozzle 10 to 12 inches away, direct spray over the animal, beginning at the tail, spray over the animal until the entire coat is damp up to the back of the neck. On longhaired dogs and cats, ruffle the coat and spray against the lay of hair, spraying directly behind hand so that spray reaches skin. For best results in controlling tick infestations, locate ticks and spray directly on them. Avoid spraying face and genitals. An application of 30 to 45 seconds is usually sufficient for an average size dog, for cats about 10 seconds is adequate. Repeat application weekly if necessary.

NOTE: Do not treat or cause exposure of kittens or puppies less than twelve (12) weeks old.

To control infestation in kennels or sleeping quarters, after treating animals as directed, spray bedding, walls, cracks, crevices, and flooring. Always remove infested bedding before spraying in kennels or sleeping quarters.
