DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LICE AND HORN FLY CONTROL:

Suspend Dri-Bye in areas frequented by the animals or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, the bag may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the animal.

HAND DUSTING:

Apply approximately 2 ounces of dust per animal for cattle by means of a shaker can, rotary duster or by spoon. Cover the upper portions of the back, neck and poll and to the face as an aid in the control of face flies. Rub in lightly to carry the dust beneath the hair. Repeat as necessary.

Apply approximately 3-4 ounces per animal for swine using the same equipment listed above. Give special attention to the neck and around the ears. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

Dispose of bags according to approved Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
