The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Please update the Note to Physician as follows:

Note to Physician: Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are persent, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

2. The product name is misleading with reference to the term "Aqueous" base. The product contains no water itself but is used in the formulation of water based products. Thus, please revise the name at the next label printing.
