DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Turf Pest Diagnostic Aid is for determining the presence of many turf insects. It is very irritating to webworms, cutworms, and other caterpillars and causes them to come to the surface within 10 minutes after application.

Use this product to detect turf insects or to determine the degree of control obtained following use of recommended control practices.

NET CONTENTS _____

Mix one tablespoon ($\frac{1}{2}$ ounce) in about one pint of water to create a pre-emulsion. This is then diluted with water to a one gallon quantity. Apply evenly with a sprinkling can over 1 square yard of turf. Repeat procedure on 2 or 3 similar areas per 5000 square feet. Insects will emerge in 10 minutes. The number and species should be noted to allow proper corrective measures to be taken, but extensive insecticidal treatments are usually not justified unless more than 5 cutworms or 15 webworms are found per square yard. The Diagnostic Aid does not bring white grubs or the grubs of billbugs to the surface, and for these it is necessary to examine the soil around grass roots.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
