bugs, mealy bugs and thrips. Follow line 1 above. Apply to treat the upper and lower leaf surfaces.

To control whiteflies, follow line 2 in the application chart. Spraying should start as soon as flies appear and repeat at 3 to 4 day intervals until no flies are seen.

To control spider mites or severe whitefly infestations, follow line 3 in the application chart.

This product may be used in greenhouses or gardens on all ornamental plants except blooming African Violet or Maiden Hair Fern.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fullers' earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
