It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

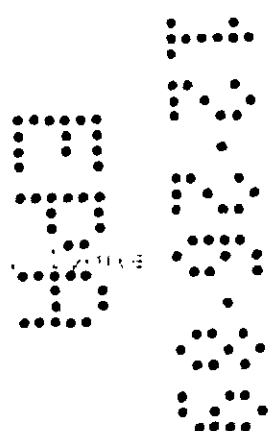
Application may be made using conventional mechanical or compressed air equipment or ULV equipment.

When diluting with water, prepare only that amount needed for immediate use. Holding a water dilution more than 24 hours is not recommended. Agitate occasionally.

To control aphids, earwigs, leafminers, leafhoppers, etc.



2. Apply spray and feed to the foliage line 1 above. Do not treat the upper and lower leaf surfaces.

3. Control caterpillars. Follow line 2 on the application chart. If caterpillars are seen as soon as they start to feed, repeat at 3 to 4 day intervals until no flies are seen.

4. Control spider mites or severe whitefly infestation. Follow line 3 in the application chart.

This product may be used on seedlings or plants of ornamental plants except Blooming African Violet or Winter Hair Fern.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fullers earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray or more or less which that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Use container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Start artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

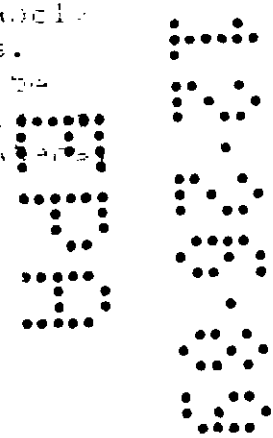
IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
