Hold bottle upright and point nozzle opening in desired direction of spray. Spray the animal from a distance of 3 - 12 inches.

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face. Repeat as necessary.

*Equivalent to 0.48% (butylcarbityl)(6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.12% related compounds.
