

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

#### ON PETS

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face, or genitals. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray on nursing females or pets under six weeks of age.

#### ON LIVESTOCK

To protect cattle, horses and hogs from Horn Files, House Files, Mosquitoes and Gnats apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. To control Stable Files, Horse Files and Deer Files. apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult animal sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To contro! Blood Sucking Lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.

To control Poultry Lice, spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

For control of **Bedbugs** and **Mites** in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the Bedbugs and Mites hide.

#### **ON PREMISES**

To control Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks on premises: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and localized areas loor and floor co. ing. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and direct sunlight. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center. Induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious per-

IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN: Flush affected areas with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
