## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE.

FOR PERSONAL USE - EXTERNAL ONLY

Head Lice and Nits:

Spray on scalp and hair. Rub in with fingers. Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer. Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap. Dead lice and eggs may require removal with a fine comb. Do not exceed two consecutive applications within 24 hours.

Pubic (Crab) Lice:

Spray affected parts and allow to dry. Wait 15 minutes and then wash with warm water and soap. Use a fine comb to remove dead lice and nits.

Body Lice:

Treat as for pubic lice. Also thoroughly treat clothing as directed below.

## FOR USE IN INANIMATE SURFACES

Including garments, bedding, mattresses, furniture, floors and carpeting. Hold can upright with nozzle away from you. Press button and spray surface to be treated from a distance of 10 inches. First treat an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration, inspect after drying, then proceed to spray the entire area to be treated. Treat each square foot for 3 seconds, directing the spray to moisten all infested surfaces.

In treating bedding: make sure the spray is directed into all corners of fitted sheets and blankets as well as the inside and outside of pillow cases. In treating garments and headwear, (including sports gear that may be passed from player to player) close attention should be given to seams, hems, cuffs, collars, and creases. After treatment, bedding and all garments must be either laundered in hot water or dry cleaned.

For mattresses, furniture and carpeting: Direct spray to moisten all folds, tucks, seams and crevices of infested areas. Allow the treated surfaces to dry completely before use.

## DISPOSAL

Wrap container and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Use with adequate ventilation. Wash head or affected area with soap and water prior to application. Do not spray in area of eyes, nose, ears or mouth, if these areas are affected, spray liberally on clean, sterile, cotton pads and carefully apply to these areas. If sprayed directly into eyes, wash with water, if irritation persists consult a physician.

**IMPORTANT:** Should be used with caution by ragweed sensitized persons.
