This product is designed for treatment of clothing off the body only. Under no circumstances should bare skin or clothing on the body be treated.

to (in bold lettering)

This product should not be applied to clothing while it is being worn. Under no circumstances should bare skin or clothing on the body be treated.

d. Based on the results of the risk assessment conducted for this formulation, this product must not be applied more than every two weeks. Furthermore, this product has demonstrated residual protection that lasts a minimum of two weeks and holds up through several machine washing. Thus, revise the Retreatment Instructions from "Do not retreat within 1 week of previous treatment." to

Do not retreat clothing more than once every two weeks.

e. Delete "other biting pests" from the label or else specify what particular insects this product kills.

f. Add to the Precautionary Statements:

Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

g. Change "Physical Hazards" to "Physical or Chemical Hazards."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

This product is designed for treatment of clothing off the body only. Under no circumstances should bare skin or clothing on the body be treated.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

For protection against Ticks (including those known to carry Lyme disease), chiggers and mosquitoes, apply product as directed below. For further protection, use in conjunction with an insect repellent registered for direct application to the skin and utilize the following primary preventive measures; Avoid areas where the pests are found, wear appropriate protective clothing (light-colored, long-sleeved shirt and long pants tucked into socks) and inspect body daily for ticks. Pant cuffs should be worn inside the socks or footwear to ensure full protection against ticks and chiggers.

INITIAL TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Select a well-ventilated outdoor area protected from wind and lay out the clothing to be treated (as complete outfit; shirt, trousers and socks).
2. Hold can upright about 6 to 8 inches from surface of the clothing and spray with a slow sweeping motion to lightly moisten the surface of the fabric.
3. Continue spraying over entire outfit, until a total treatment time of 60 seconds has elapsed and the outer surface of the fabric is moist enough to cause a slight color change or darkening. Pay special attention to socks, trouser cuffs and shirt cuffs.
4. Turn the clothing over and treat the other side as described in Steps 2 & 3.
5. Hang the treated clothing and allow to dry for at least 2 hours (4 hours under humid conditions) before wearing.
6. One can will treat two complete outfits. Do not exceed recommended spraying times.

RETREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

This product contains Permethrin which actually binds to the fabric and provides residual protection for up to 2 weeks, and holds up to 10 washings. DO NOT RETREAT CLOTHING PREVIOUS TREATED WITH PERMANONE. AT LEAST ONCE BEFORE retreatment, follow instructions.

Replace cap, wrap in newspaper. Discard if punctured.

PRECAUTIONS HAZARDS TO HUMANS

Avoid contact with face. Avoid inhaling vapors or spray near treated surfaces until dry. Do not spray to contact food, or use by small children.
