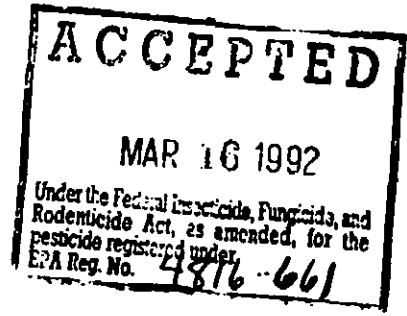

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill FLEAS and LICE, pour one tablespoon of this concentrate into one gallon of water. To kill TICKS, make solution 4 times as strong. Saturate dog's coat thoroughly for several minutes and dry without rinsing. Repeat when necessary. To kill lice on long-haired dogs, bathe first with soap and water. Rinse out soap. Then use the above solution as the final rinse.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

CONTAINERS ONE GALLON AND SMALLER: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.



STATEMENT OF FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. If person is conscious, give small sips of water. If unconscious, do not give anything by mouth. Contact a physician. Contains petroleum distillate.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN: Flush affected areas with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, potholes). Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.
