Your amended application of January 19, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Change the use directions as follows:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation ... with its labeling.

Use Restrictions:

For use only on dogs to kill fleas, ticks, and lice. Do not use on cats. Do not treat puppies less than 4 weeks of age. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

Application Directions:

For short-haired dogs:

To kill fleas and lice, mix one tablespoon per gallon of water. To kill ticks, mix four tablespoons per gallon. Saturate dog's coat thoroughly for several minutes and dry without rinsing.

For long-haired dogs:

To kill fleas and ticks, follow directions for short-haired dogs. To kill lice, first bathe dog with soap and water. Rinse out soap. Then follow directions for short-haired dogs as a final rinse.

Retreatment Instructions:

Retreat when necessary.

2. Use the current name of the registrant, Agrevo Environmental Health, on the label.
3. Structure your PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals  
Statement of Practical Treatment  
Environmental Hazards  
Physical and Chemical Hazards

4. Place a heading, such as NOTE before "Buyer assumes ... given herewith."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill FLEAS and LICE, pour one tablespoon of this concentrate into one gallon of water. To kill TICKS, make solution 4 times as strong. Saturate dog's coat thoroughly for several minutes and dry without rinsing. Repeat when necessary. To kill lice on long-haired dogs, bathe first with soap and water. Rinse out soap. Then use the above solution as the final rinse.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE AND PROCEDURES:** Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperature. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless directed to do so by a physician. Contains Petroleum Distillate.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN: Flush affected areas with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
