DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Well Before Use

To operate hold can upright, direct orifice toward the surface to be treated, and press the actuator button. Do not use as a space spray.

To kill ants, carpet beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, silverfish, spiders, and pillbugs: thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards, and door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill brown dog ticks: apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, and nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pet with this product.

To control house flies, gnats, hornets, mosquitoes, small flying moths, wasps and yellow jackets: use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.
