STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician. This product contains a high amount of petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If Inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If in Eyes or on Skin: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This ready-to-use concentrate may be dispersed through good mechanical, thermal or compressed air fogging or spraying equipment. If used in edible product areas of Federally inspected meat, poultry, shell egg grading and egg product establishments, it must be dispersed as an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns in diameter and 80% less than 30 microns).

To control house flies, mosquitoes, gnats, hidges and small flying insects, close room and spray into the air. Adjust the nozzle of the sprayer to give the finest mist possible. Spray at a rate of 3/1 to 1 fluid ounce per 1000 cubic feet or until a moderate mist can be seen in all parts of the room. If it is not necessary to spray the air heavily, keep the room closed for 10 minutes.

To control wasps using the above described application, spray late in the evening when insects are at rest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or burn and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local authorities.

A container size of 30 gallons or more may be resented and offered for reconditioning.
