### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

##### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Vacate premises after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and water

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not use on dogs or cats under twelve (12) weeks old. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

#### Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### DISPOSAL

**Disposal:** Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate.

SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE.

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range.

**COCKROACHES, PALMETTO BUGS, WATERBUGS, SILVER-FISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, PILLBUGS, SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES AND SOW BUGS:** Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on Ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, MIDGES, WASPS, HORNETS AND FLYING MOTHS (MILLERS):** Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**BEDBUGS:** Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and frames. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To kill **Fleas** and **Brown Dog Ticks** on dogs, cats and premises: Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs and on other areas except genitalia. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until animal hair is thoroughly saturated. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat application weekly if necessary.

To reduce reinfestation thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting areas until the surface is slightly moist. Also spray the entire inside surface of doghouses and kennels, thoroughly spraying floors, cracks, crevices and bedding. Hit as many insects directly as possible. Repeat as necessary.

**Indian Meal Moths** and **Angoumois Grain Moths**: Close doors and windows. Direct spray into all parts of room especially around stored food product containers, pallets and darkened areas. Spray 7 to 10 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for 15 minutes following treatment. Repeat application as necessary.

**CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES, GRANARY WEEVILS, RICE WEEVILS, RED FLOUR BEETLES AND GRAIN MITES**: Spray into cracks and crevices, processing and handling equipment, around cartons or containers and other areas where these insects tend to congregate. Spray 30 seconds for each 100 square feet of surface. Keep area closed for 45 minutes to 1 hour after treatment. Repeat application as necessary.
