Use outdoors and in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a preharvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

To control listed insects combine 1.0 fluid ounce of emulsion per 1 gallon of water. Apply to insure thorough coverage of upper and lower surfaces.

VEGETABLES

CROPS: asparagus, beans, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, celery, collards, cranberries, cucumbers, eggplant, kale, lettuce, melons, mustard greens, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, sweet corn, tomatoes and turnips.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: aphids, asparagus beetles, blister beetles, cabbage loopers, Colorado potato beetles, cross-striped cabbage worms, diamondback caterpillars, flea beetles, green peach aphids, harlequin bugs, imported cabbageworms, Japanese beetles, leafhoppers, leafminers, Mexican bean beetles, stink bugs, 12-spotted cucumber beetles, webworms and whiteflies.

ORNAMENTALS, TREES, SHRUBS AND ROSES

Apply as a fine mist, spraying plants on the upper and lower leaf surfaces.

INSECTS CONTROLLED: aphids (red, black and green peach), bagworms, thrips, flea beetles, Japanese beetles, lace bugs, leafhoppers, leaf rollers, leafminers, mealybugs, webworm larvae, plant bugs and whiteflies. Repeat treatment weekly, or as needed to control infestations.

To kill gypsy moth caterpillars and adult, adult Japanese beetles and Eastern and forest tent caterpillars on contact.

On Trees and Shrubs:

Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days as necessary for control.

On Roses and in Flower Gardens: Treat plants and foliage as soon as insects appear on plants and flowers. Repeat application days or as necessary for control.

YARDS, PORCHES, PATIOS AND G

Spray the surface areas and hit whenever possible.

Ants: Spray trails, nests, and try. Spray on ants where possible if necessary.

Wasps & Hornets: Apply at dusk. Are at nest. Spray liberally in and breeding places contacting a sects as possible. Repeat if ne

Spiders: Spray directly on spider. Repeat if necessary.

AS A SURFACE SPRAY: For initial severe insect infestation, dilute of 1 part concentrate in 14 parts fluid ounces per gallon. For n tations dilute 1 part concentrate parts water (4.3 ounces per gall

To kill cockroaches, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, centipedes, millipedes, silverfish and cloverworms, spray into hiding places such as cracks, moist areas, openings around pip storage areas and sheds. Spray insects where possible. Repeat necessary.

To kill mosquitoes, gnats (midges), biting flies and small flies (millers), apply spray to shrub and grassy areas. Spray these a slow sweeping motion while moving the treated area. To reduce these flying insects, treat open patios in a similar manner. For results, spray when air is still. Spray to dissipate before occupy treated area. Repeat if necessary.
