### Hazards to Humans

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS, FLEAS AND LICE ON DOGS AND CATS AS A DIP, dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

For control of ear mites, while dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS, FLEAS AND LICE ON DOGS AND CATS AS A SPONGE-ON, dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water (1:32). Sponge on animal, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

For control of ear mites, lightly sponge inside of ears. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.

### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
