




TO CONTROL: Lice, Ticks, Fleas - Apply this product to animal, working it into skin. Where ticks are seen, apply them directly. Repeat once a week if necessary.

Use on animal bedding, floor, and around animal living quarters at rate of 1 ounce per 50 square feet.

In laboratories breeding small animals such as mice and guinea pigs, etc. Mix this product into animal bedding at rate of 45 grams per 135 grams of bedding. Floors should be swept well.

Do not use on reptiles or fish. Do not use on kittens or puppies less than four weeks old or mice, gerbils or hamsters less than five days old.

TO CONTROL: Cockroaches, Ants, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish - Apply this product lightly, but completely along baseboards, around pipes of sinks, stoves, bathtubs, fixtures, behind and under appliances, cabinets, and in cracks and crevices where these insects hide. For particular attention to door and window sills. Repeat application often as necessary. Use 1 ounce per 50 square feet.
