DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL: LICE, TICKS, FLEAS - Apply this product to body of animal, working it into skin. Where ticks are seen, dust them directly. Repeat once a week if necessary.

Use on animal bedding, floor and around animal living quarters at the rate of 1 ounce per 50 square feet.

NET CONTENTS: _____

In laboratories breeding all animals such as mice, rat guinea pigs, etc. mix this product into animal bedding at a rate of 45 grams per 135 grams of bedding. Floors should be treated as well.

Do not use on reptiles or fish. Do not use on kittens or pups less than four weeks old or mice, gerbils or hamsters less than five days old.

TO CONTROL: COCKROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO SILVERFISH - Apply this product lightly, but completely, baseboards, around pipes of sinks, stoves, bathroom fixtures behind and under appliances, cabinets, and in all crack crevices where these insects hide. For ants, pay particular attention to door and window sills. Repeat as often as necessary. Use 1 ounce per 50 square feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged breathing of powder and contact with skin. Wash hands after using. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children.

Do not treat puppies or kittens less than four weeks of age. Do not apply directly to genitalia. Avoid exposure of pets to this product.

Cover or remove fish aquaria in areas to be treated.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a Physician or Poison Control immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting if anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Use artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
