DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in Hotels, Motels, Homes, Food Handling Establishments, Packaging and Processing Plants, Seed Houses, Commercial, Industrial, Office, Institutional and Storage Buildings, Milk Handling Areas of Milk Plants, Milk Storage Rooms, Egg Processing Plants, Supermarkets, Restaurants, Bottling Plants, Canneries, Bakeries, Schools, Warehouses, Boats, Ship Cabins and Hospitals. IN HOSPITALS, remove patients prior to treatment. Ventilate rooms for two hours before returning patients. Also for use in Buses, Automobiles, Trucks, Bicycles, and Ship Cargo Holds.

NET CONTENTS

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food surfaces should be covered during treatment and thoroughly cleaned before use. After space spraying in food processing plants, all equipment, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled should be washed with an effective cleaning compound and rinsed with potable water. This product in these areas, apply only when facility is not in operation.

This concentrate is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers adjusted to deliver an aerosol spray (no droplets over 50 microns diameter and 80% less than 30 microns).

SPACE SPRAY: Use undiluted in aerosol generators to kill accessible stages of:

Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 0.3 ounces of undiluted concentrate per 1000 cubic feet of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward toward upper corners of room. Leave room closed for at least one hour. Vacate treated area and before reoccupying. Repeat as necessary.

NOTE: Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter treated areas without clothing until sprays have dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, absorb with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.
