DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results, dust liberally over entire body of pet. Beginning at head, rub powder to skin. Apply to feet, pads, and between toes. Repeat treatment if necessary.

Apply liberally to pet bedding and surroundings including furniture, carpeting, baseboards, etc.

NON-FOOD AREAS: To control crawling insects such as ants, cockroaches, silverfish, spiders, ticks, lice and fleas in animal quarters, distribute at the rate of 1 ounce per 50 square feet of surface area. Apply continuous visible film underneath and behind stairs, refrigerators and appliances. Treat on, around and behind moldings, shelving, baseboards, pipe openings, cracks, crevices and other areas where insects hide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged breathing of powder or contact with skin. Wash hands after using.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
