Your request to change the precautionary language on labeling for this product to meet the requirements of the State of California is acceptable. You may change the statement, "May be harmful if swallowed" to "May be fatal if swallowed."

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the additional labeling changes given below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

In the Precautionary Statements section add "Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse." Change "Causes eye irritation" to "Causes substantial but temporary eye injury."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
